### **DIRECTIONS**

St Michael's Church – The Sanctuary, Church Street, Ewell Village, Surrey KT17 2AS



St. Michael's is  
between nos 4-6  
Church Street.

### **BY TRAIN**

#### **Directions from Ewell West train station (about 10 minutes)**

Come out of station on the main exit side not where the alley way is.  
At main road turn left and walk down to traffic lights.  
Here the road splits into a fork – take the right fork.  
Soon after on your left is a turning, which looks like you are going into a car park – it has half iron gates in a greeny colour, which are, open. This is the car exit to Bourne Hall and is a good short cut for you.  
Walk through car park and diagonally across is the exit.  
(If you miss this bit then you'll just follow the road round to this point)  
Turn left out of car park. End of road – turn right  
Go past local village shops (post office, health food shop etc).  
Cross over at the pedestrian lights opposite the chemist & health food shop  
Turn first left into Church Street. St Michael's is about 50 yards up on the right. Cross the small courtyard and if the door is locked, please ring the bell and I will come down to let you in.

#### **Directions from Ewell East Station (about 5 minutes)**

Out of station on car park side (not the side going to Nescott college).  
End of road turn left  
Get to big road junction (dual carriageway)  
Cross straight over into Cheam Road  
In about 150 meters you will Sainsburys Local on your left and a car park on your right.  
Keep on the side opposite Sainsburys. At the end of the road turn left. Do not turn left into Ewell High Street). Church Street is approximately 30 yards ahead on your right. St Michael's is about 50 yards up on the right. Cross the small courtyard and if the door is locked, please ring the bell and I will come down to let you in.

## **BY CAR**

### **Directions from Junction 8 on the M25 – CLOCKWISE - coming from Dartford Tunnel direction**

Take the last exit off the roundabout - A217 towards Sutton

Carry on this road (dual carriageway) for about 3 miles - you will go over at least two roundabouts.

You will then get to a set of traffic lights - you need the left hand lane - it goes into a left hand filter.

At these traffic lights turn left on to the A240 - Reigate Road

Carry along this road for another 3-4 miles. You will go over roundabouts and cross some traffic lights.

When you see Nescott training college on your right - immediately after that is a roundabout (petrol station opposite with Tesco shop and Homebase on the other side of the roundabout).

At this roundabout take the third (last) exit on to the A24

At the next set of traffic lights turn left into Cheam Road.

In about 150 meters you will see Sainsburys Local on your left and a car park on your right.

This is the best place to park. Walking out of the car park turn right (with Sainsburys opposite you) and then at the end of the road turn right. Church Street is approximately 30 yards ahead on your right. St Michael's is about 50 yards up on the right. Cross the small courtyard and if the door is locked, please ring the bell and I will come down to let you in. T

here is a car park opposite Sainsbury's Local.

### **Directions from M25 – ANTICLOCKWISE - coming from Heathrow direction**

Leave the M25 at junction 10 and take the left exit joining the A3 towards London. Leave the A3 after 9 miles at the Tolworth (Tower) exit marked A240. Take the A240 towards Sutton (3<sup>rd</sup> exit).

Continue on this dual carriageway (it starts off as the Kingston Road and then goes into the Ewell bypass and then the A24). You will cross over a few sets of lights and roundabouts.

You will come to a large set of traffic lights where there is Shurgard Storage on your left, and a Honda car sales garage on your right. Leave the A24 here, turning right, (it has it's own set of traffic lights for turning right). Follow this road round, past a church on your left and then the Spring Tavern pub on your right. Continue on keeping in the left hand lane as you cross the next set of traffic lights. Soon after these traffic lights you will see Church Street on your left and St. Michael's is about 50 yards up here on the right.. Cross the small courtyard and if the door is locked, please ring the bell and I will come down to let you in.

Car Park: To park in the car park, don't turn up Church Street but continue on for about 30metres. The road bends round to the right. Turn left here into Cheam Road. You will see Sainsburys Local on the right hand side. Immediately opposite this is the car park.
